



#### **EFFECTS BOX**


**PARTS: 031-B, 035-A** Fit the stunt team effects box (**031-B**) to the floor panel as shown, fixing with a Type L screw driven through the underside of the floor panel.





#### STEP 5

#### **CONTROL CONSOLE**


PARTS: 005-B, 035-A In the raised central section of the floor panel, carefully but firmly clip on the control console (005-B). There are two pegs that fit on to the floor panel. There is also a third central peg that must be fastened through the underside of the floor panel with a Type Y screw.



## STEP 6

#### **GEAR STICK**


PARTS: 029-E, 031-C, 035-A, In front of the control console is a space for the preassembled gear stick section (029-E). Clip the gear stick in. On the underside of the floor panel (035-A) clip the gear stick retainer (031-C), making sure the thinner end points to the right of the floor panel. This is retained with a single Type J screw from underneath the floor panel.



Put the assembled section to one side for a moment.



### STEP 8


PARTS: ASSEMBLED FLOOR PANEL, TRIGGER HOUSING Feed the trigger housing through the underside of the floor panel.

Use four Type F screws to attach the housing to the floor panel.



Put this section to one side for the moment.






#### **STEP 10**

#### **EJECTOR SEAT TRIGGER**


PARTS: 032-A, 034-A, ASSEMBLED FLOOR PANEL Fit the ejector seat trigger (034-A) to the ejector seat lever (032-A) as shown. Carefully place it in position over the gear stick retainer in the centre of the assembled floor panel. Use a Type J screw to fix it all together.





### **FLOOR PANEL**

#### **STEP 13** PARTS: DRIVER'S SEAT, DRIVER'S SEAT WEAPONS TRAY. **ASSEMBLED FLOOR PANEL** Place the weapons tray in FIGURE: 2 position on the floor panel as shown. Carefully place the driver's seat over the tray. This is screwed in place by two Type Y screws from underneath the floor panel. WEAPONS TRAY ASSEMBLED FIGURE: 1 TYPE Y FLOOR PANEL TYPE Y

Put this section to one side for the moment.
