
THE ENGINE & INTERIOR

Constructing the **BULKHEAD** of your Aston Martin DB5 model.

■ THE PARTS YOU WILL NEED:

- O12-E: Rear bulkhead and electrical connections
- 012-F: Screenwasher bottle
- 013-A: Header tank
- O13-B: Right bulkhead
- 013-C : Left bulkhead
- O13-D: Left brake servo
- 014-A: Right brake servo
- **014-B** : Air box
- 014-C: Cleaner hose
- 014-D : Air cleaner
- O14-E: Air cleaner cover
- O14-F : Alternator controls
- 014-G: Brake fluid reservoirs (2)
- 015-A: Starter solenoid
- O15-B : Ignition coil
- 015-C: Blower trunking
- SCREWS : Type L (x1), P (x2), Q (x12)




Constructing the **BULKHEAD** of your Aston Martin DB5 model.

STEP 1

PARTS: 012-E. 015-A. 014-G

One at a time, attach the two pieces of the brake fluid reservoir (014-G) to the rear bulkhead (O12-E).


These are fastened with two Type Q screws through the back, as shown. Clip the starter solenoid (O15-A) to the bulkhead.



STEP 2

PARTS: 014-C, 014-D


Clip the air cleaner (014-D) to the air cleaner hose (014-C). This is fastened with a single Type L screw.



STEP 3

PARTS: 014-C/014-D, 014-E


Clip the assembled air cleaner and its hose to the air cleaner cover (O14-E). This is attached by two Type P screws.





STEP 4

PARTS: ASSEMBLED










STEP 11

PARTS: THE BULKHEAD, 015-C

Clip the free end of the blower trunking to the side of the right bulkhead. Use a Type Q screw to fix this in place as shown.



Set the assembled parts aside for the moment.
